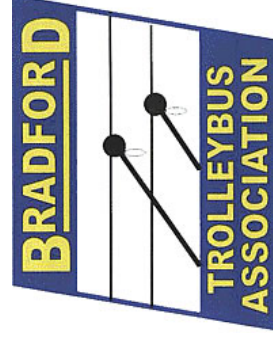

The Bradford Trolleybus Association founded in 1972 upon the closure of the Bradford Trolleybus System 26th of March. This was also the end of the trolleybus operation in Great Britain. The aims of the Association were to co-ordinate the preservation of the city's trolleybuses and eventually restore vehicles to operational condition.

### Trackless

The Association produces "Trackless" a quarterly magazine that we distribute free to members, containing articles of transport interest and local news.

### The BTA Trolleybus

The BTA owns one vehicle - 758 whilst it's members hold a variety of ex-Bradford trolleybuses. 758 has a BUT 9611T chassis with 8ft Weymann body and was registered FKU 758 on the 1st of January 1951. As a pioneering experimental flashing indicators were added. This was the first legal use of flashing indicators in Britain.

On the 31st of July 1971, 758 became the last rear entrance trolleybus in service in Great Britain. It now needs a thorough restoration to restore the vehicle to it's former glory. The Bradford Trolleybus Association is currently gathering the finances to meet the costs involved and has started the restoration project.

### Social Meetings

We hold social meetings at the Midland Hotel, Forster Square Bradford, on the second Friday of the month at 7-30pm (No Meeting in August). These meetings are open to all; members, families and friends. Guest speakers provide an interesting programme of talks, slide and film shows. As well as the use of a private room, the bar of the Hotel are available for those wishing to purchase refreshments. A small charge is made to cover hire of the room, and we also have a raffle during the interval.
